### **What is Sin? (Sin, Part 1)**

- 1. EVERY PERSON YOU MEET IS \_\_\_\_\_,

*See how very much our Father loves us, for he calls us his children, and that is what we are! But the people who belong to this world don't recognize that we are God's children because they don't know him.* 1 John 3:1

*If we claim we have no sin, we are only fooling ourselves and not living in the truth. But if we confess our sins to him, he is faithful and just to forgive us our sins and to cleanse us from all wickedness. If we claim we have not sinned, we are calling God a liar and showing that his word has no place in our hearts.* 1John 1:8-10
